They ensure that all of them comply with all relevant legal and ethical requirements relating to their research area. Researchers should promote the open exchange of ideas, research methods, data and results, and their discussion, scrutiny and debate, subject to any considerations of confidentiality. The following points are the key components of the research policy

- ❖ Researchers should respect and welcome new innovations and ideas.
 - ❖ The aim of the College is to promote research culture among the Faculty Members and Students.
 - ❖ We develop the culture in student and staff towards research.
 - ❖ To ensure that research work is original without adoption of impermissible material.
 - ❖ Plagiarism: using the ideas or words of another person without giving appropriate credit and Self-Plagiarism copying or reuse of one's own research, both types of plagiarism are considered to be unacceptable practice in research.
 - ❖ The Goa University librarian has been nominated as Shodaganga's Coordinator for the Goa University, Goa. With URKUND software as anti-plagiarism tools, the soft copy of any manuscript or thesis will be scanned systematically to pinpoint the extent of plagiarism.
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
