1. Draft a **notice of dishonour of cheque** amounting to Rs. 80,000/-. Mr. R. Singh had given a cheque Mr. Rohit. Dessai as he had purchased 1,000 purses from him for Rs.800/-. When Mr. Rohit deposited the cheque it was returned to him on the grounds of 'Insufficient Funds'. The said cheque was drawn on HDFC Bank on 2/10/2019 and it bounced on 9/10/2019.
2. Mr. Arun Sharma from Government College Panaji, age 19, had appeared for the TY examination held by Goa University in October 2019. However on 3/10/2019 he lost his marks sheet when he was shifting his house from Panaji to Miramar. His seat no was 19340 and his PRNO. Is 202068813. Draft **an affidavit** for the issue of a duplicate Mark sheet to be filed before Goa University.
3. M/s Ramesh Electricals a distribution company having its having its registered office since 2015 in Shop no. 3, Vidya Towers, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Mapusa wants to buy from Phillips Company having its head office at 3rd Floor, Tower A, DLF IT Park, 08 Block AF Major Arterial Road, New Town (Rajarhat) Kolkata, 10,000 LED tube lights for Rs. 10 Lakhs. Each tube light costing Rs.100/- Draft an **Agreement for Sale of Goods**.

4. Tom and Jerry are both business partners having its business in Panjim who had agreed to organize a beach festival on 5/12/2018. The event was a big success by which they made a total profit of Rs.500, 000/- However, Jerry failed to return the tables and chairs which were rented, whereas Tom failed to pay the hall charges to Mr. T. Fernandes. Tom's fine amounts to Rs 15,000/- whereas Jerry's fine amounts to Rs.18000/-. They have appointed Mr. R Naik as the conciliator. Draft a **Conciliation Agreement**.

Rama Catering company having its office at Panaji intends to hire 20 round plastic tables and 40 plastic chairs and 20 tents from 'Sam's Rent a tent' for a 3 day Food festival for a hire charge of Rs.50 a day for 20 tables and Rs.20 a day for 40 umbrellas and Rs 10 a day for 20 tents. Draft the **Agreement for Bailment**.
