1. Reena Dessai lost her driving license bearing no. GA07Z-2014-099032, date of issue 24/8/2016. She had a license for light motor vehicle on 1st October 2018. Draft an affidavit for the issue of a duplicate driving license to be filed before the Road Transport Authority.
2. An event organiser intends to hire 20 tents and 15 beach Umbrellas from 'Sam's Rent a tent' for a 5 day beach festival from a hire charge of Rs.3000 a day for 20 tents and Rs.1500 a day for 15 umbrellas. Draft the agreement for bailment.
3. Mr. Tony Gomes wants to take a loan from his neighbour Mr. Royston Pinto as he is painting his house. The total amount borrowed by Tom is Rs. 60,000/- . Both agreed that the interest rate shall be 5% per annum as they are very well know to each other and the term of the loan is for 2yrs. They have agreed that the instalment per month shall be Rs.2750/-. Draft a simple loan agreement.
4. Draft a notice of dishonour of cheque amounting to Rs. 50,000/-. Mr. R. Tendulkar had given a cheque Mr. Y. Khan that was drawn on Bank of India on 25/9/2018 and it bounced on 4/10/2018.
5. Draft an Arbitration agreement between Mr. A, Mr. B and Mr. C who are partners of M/s Blue automobiles Goa to decide whether the notice of dissolution given by one partner Mr. C is valid and if so, the date of dissolution and If not to decide whether the other parties are entitled to continue the said business without the said Mr. C and to decide the date of his retirement.
