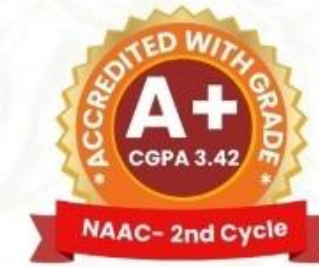

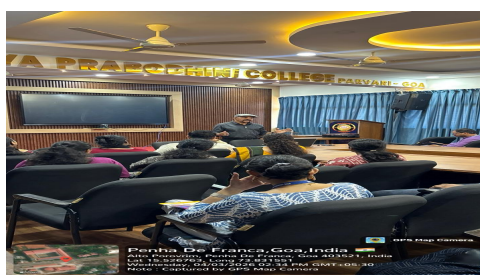

A brief write-up about your Event (in about 300 words) : Vidya Prabodhini College of Education organized a one-day workshop on “Outcome Based Education (OBE) in Higher Education” on 24 January 2026 at the college premises. The programme was conducted for the teaching faculty with the primary objective of familiarizing them with the principles and effective implementation of Outcome Based Education, as mandated by the University Grants Commission (UGC). The workshop commenced with an inaugural session, followed by an address by the Vice Principal, Dr. Ujvala Hanjunker. In her address, she emphasized the growing importance of aligning teaching–learning processes with clearly defined learning outcomes to enhance the overall quality of education and to ensure the development of student competencies in a structured manner. The resource person for the workshop, Mr. Ganesh Chandra Naik, Associate Professor at GVM’s Dr. Dada Vaidya College of Education, Ponda, delivered an insightful and comprehensive session on the relevance of OBE in



higher education institutions. He elaborated on the systematic process of formulating Programme Learning Outcomes (PLOs) and Course Learning Outcomes (CLOs), and highlighted the importance of mapping these outcomes effectively with each other as well as with the prescribed syllabus. Furthermore, Mr. Naik stressed the need to align learning outcomes with assessment practices, particularly in the setting of question papers, to ensure that evaluation methods accurately measure the intended outcomes. His session provided valuable guidance on designing outcome-oriented curricula and adopting appropriate assessment strategies. The interactive nature of the workshop allowed participants to seek clarifications and engage in meaningful discussions, thereby enriching their understanding of the subject. The programme concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by the Head of the Department, Dr. Anil Thosare, who expressed sincere gratitude to the resource person, the organizing team, and all participants for their enthusiastic involvement and contribution to the success of the workshop.
