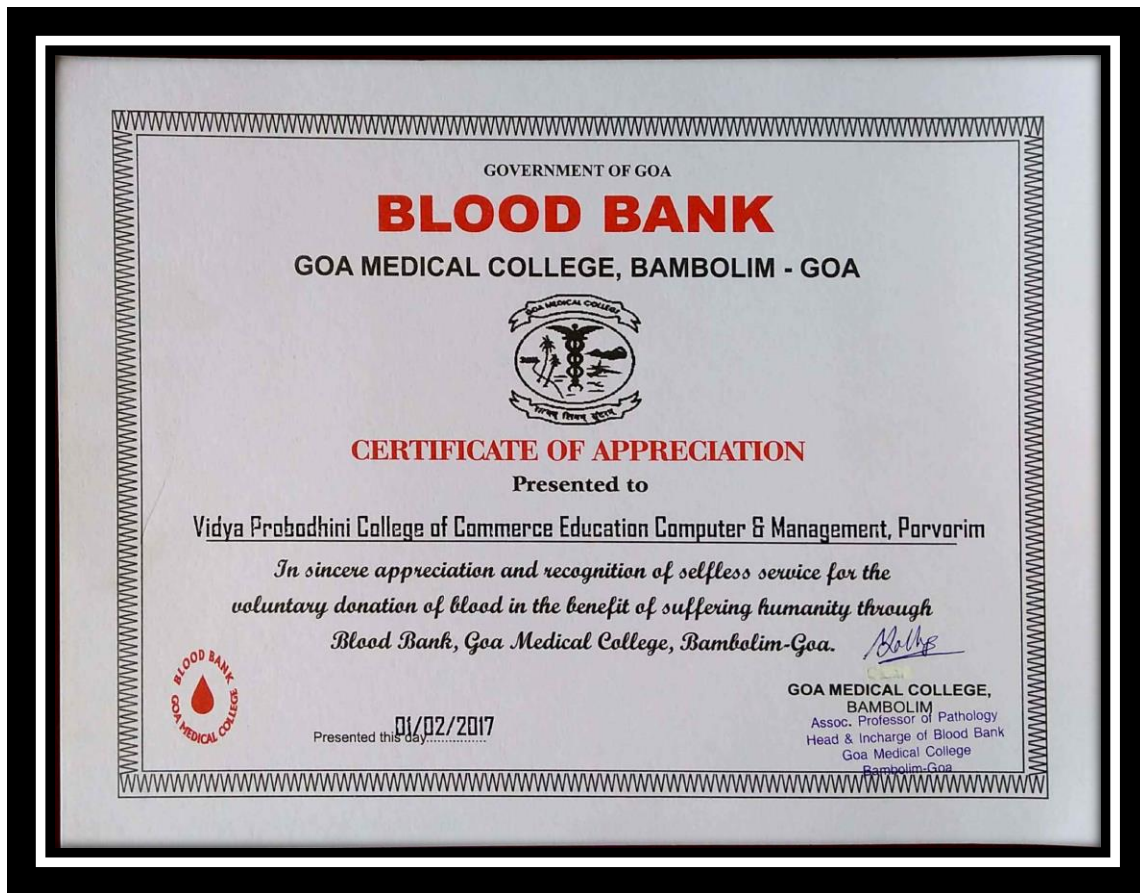


Community Service
