- ii. Latitudinal Interval - 15°
- iii. Longitudinal Interval - 30°

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Q.4. Construct a Simple Conical projection with one standard parallel for the Northern Hemisphere by using non-prospective method from the following scale. Explain its properties along with its applications. (1x10=10)

- i. Map Scale: R.F. 1: 18,00,00,00,000
- ii. Latitudinal Interval - 15°
- iii. Longitudinal Interval - 30°
- iv. Latitudinal Extent - 15°N to 75°N
- v. Longitudinal Extent - 0° to 120° East and West Hemisphere
- vi. Standard Parallel – 45°
