In continuation to this Ministry's DO dated 28.07.2023, I would like to apprise you about the endeavour of this Ministry to weed out fraudulent elements from the 26 lakh applications whose scholarships for the year 2022-23 have been withheld due to findings of evaluation study conducted by National Council of Applied Economics and Research (NCAER) for Scholarship Scheme of Ministry of Minority Affairs.

2. In the aforesaid study instances of gross irregularities has been revealed wherein benefit of Scholarship Schemes is found not reaching to the targeted beneficiaries. The report has also highlights involvement of unscrupulous elements in collusion with school/college authorities, Institutional Nodal Officers (INOs) and District Nodal Officers (DNOs) to carry out fraud.

3 The issue was elaborately reviewed with officials of National Scholarship Portal (NSP) and Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) to devise a strategy to weed out fraudulent elements and has been decided to conduct Aadhar based Biometric Authentication of officials' i.e. INOs, Head of Institutes as well as beneficiaries to weed out fraudulent elements from the system. Since NSP Software does not have provision of Bio metric authentication the ministry has engaged CSC to conduct the Bio metric authentication in next 30 days with strict timelines (copy of revised timeline & State nodal officials of CSC are enclosed).

4. As conveyed vide aforesaid DO, the exercise will be conducted in the leadership of the State Nodal Officer (SNO) and District Nodal Officers (DNOs) of the State, and therefore role of these officials become crucial to complete the drive in a time bound manner. The Biometric Authentication of INOs, Head of Institutes (HoIs) and DNOs shall be carried out at District Headquarter by organizing camps at district level or at any other location convenient to stakeholders. He may conduct more than one camps in his district as per the convenience of stakeholders but his presence in the camp is mandatory. The Biometric Authentication of applicants shall be held in their respective Schools/Institutions. A copy of SoP devised for the process is **annexed** for reference.
