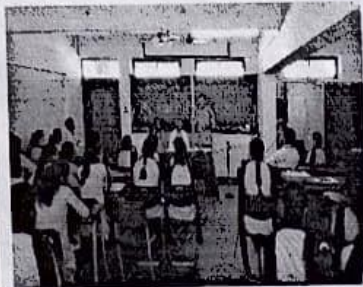

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

Department of education, Vidya Prabodhini College of Commerce Education, Computer and Management, Porvorim organised a talk on 'Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009' for first year BA BED teacher trainees.

Resource person for the same was headmaster of Government School Kundai, Ponda, Vishal Signapurkar. While addressing those present Signapurkar created awareness about Article 21 A (2002) and a historic state legislation about education. He sensitised students about free and compulsory education, corporal punishment, harassment, dropout, enrollment, special training, soften barriers and psychological abuse.

He also informed them about the qualifications for appointments of teachers, their academic responsibilities, private tuition, and deployment of teacher and other roles of teachers. He discussed norms and standards of school, their community participation, capitation fee and admission rules. He then focused on the 10 main functions of RTE Act 2009. He advised teacher trainees to become resourceful teachers and concluded by saying that 'quality of teachers and the teaching-learning process plays an important role in students learning'.

The programme was attended by 90 students.
