

Backdrop







With the higher education ecosystem impacted directly through scores Academic for Performance Indicators acquired (API) recruitments and career advancement, the refresher course like the present becomes beneficial. Present Refresher Course is designed for Geographers and all those for whom Geography Matters. Geography crops up everywhere, yet whose uses seem to be changing recurrently, producing new and often surprising variations of meaning. COVID 19 has added a visual meaning to geography with a mega display of maps and spatial data. Geo analytics have never been pitched so high by researchers as today. The course aims to target Geography faculty, Cartographers, Environmental Geographers, Social Scientists, Demographers, Urban and Rural

Planners, Geo-Political experts, Gender experts, and all others who value locations, place, space and have ever wished to use remote sensing, GPS, and GIS in their research and academic writings. Certificate Course in Computerized Accounting in Higher Educational Institutions

Objective: To enable course participants acquire knowledge of principles and framework of accounting in higher educational institutions and develop skills in practice of accounting using software applications.

CONCEPT NOTE





Established in the year 1922, the University Library shifted to its present locale in 1958 and developed into Delhi University Library System

around 1974. DULS is accomplishing its task of reaching to wider academic community. It is one of the largest academic library systems of the country with about 1.6 million books, 1296 current print journals, 4,56,806 bound back volumes of journals, and 27, 539 thesis and dissertations in its collections. The core DULS collection is computerized with the provision of a centralized Web OPAC facility to cater to the information needs across various disciplines. In 2018, the College conducted a Course on Human Rights, Environment and Ethics through its National Resource Centre (NRC), under the Annual Refresher Programme in Teaching (ARPIT) scheme of MoE. It is also working for collaboration with other higher education institutions located in remote areas of the country, under the Vidya Vistar Scheme of the University of Delhi.


