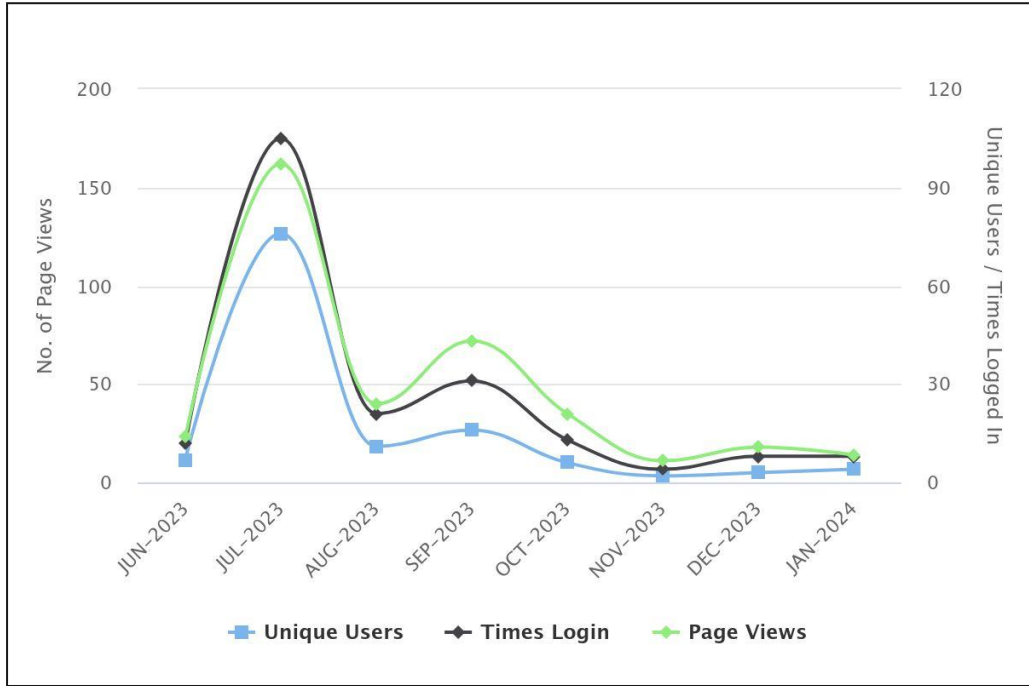

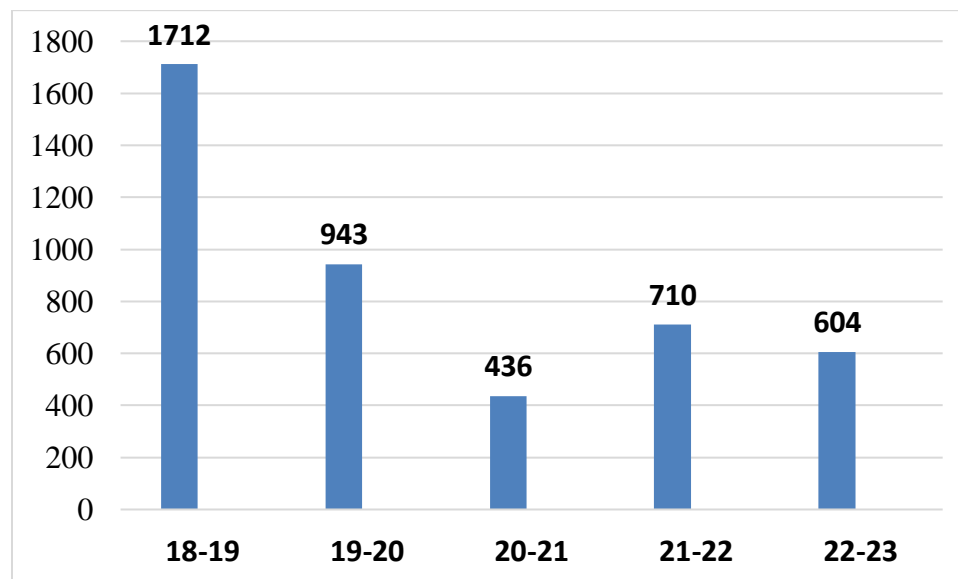
Year wise chart of Books Added



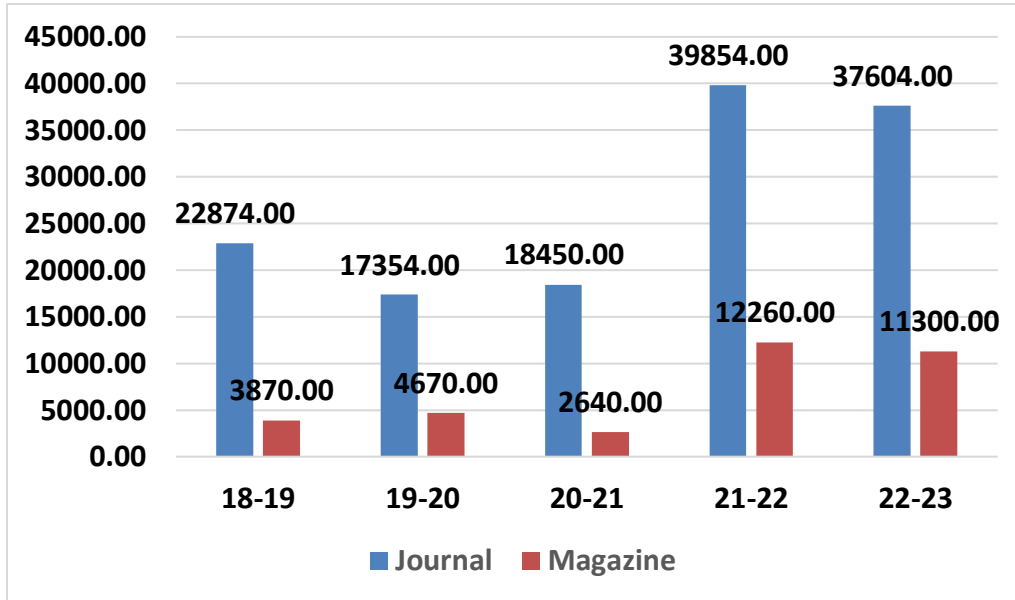
Year wise Library Expenditure

Infrastructure of the Library

- 1) **Circulation Counter:** The library has a Circulation counter which is equipped with one Computer and an internet connection. The computer is also installed with KOHA Library Management software.
- 2) **Journals and Magazines Display Racks:** Used to display all the periodicals subscribed by the library.
- 3) **New Arrivals Display:** Used to display newly added books in the Library. Students are also informed about new arrivals through Library Notice Board
- 4) **Notice Board:** Used to display Library Rules, Newspaper clippings, and important library notices.



- 5) **Reading Room:** At a time 80 students can sit in the library.
- 6) **Photocopying Machine:** Photocopy facilities at reasonable charges are available for students in the library.



- 7) **Computers:** The library is equipped with 6 computers.
- 8) **UPS backup:** All the computers from the library have the backup facility.

ICT Infrastructure

The library website contains information about the Rules of the library, different Subject Gateways, Exam question papers, Periodicals subscribed by the library, and various other useful links for students and faculties.

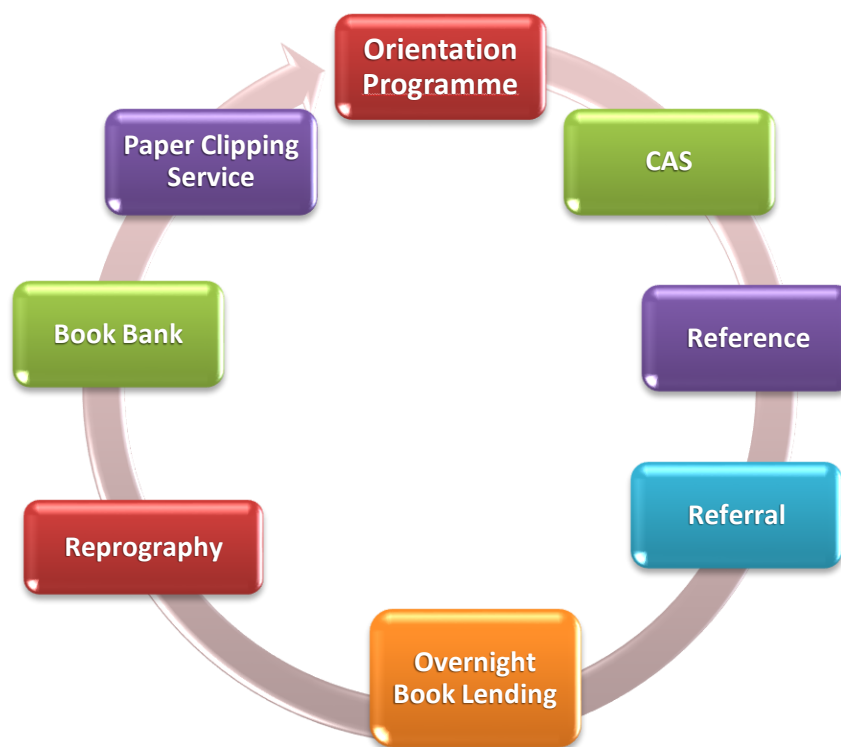
- **KOHA SOFTWARE**: All the details of the Library collection are digitized using this software.

Library Services

The library offers the following services to its users.



- 1) **Orientation Programme**: Orientation Programme takes place at the beginning of the academic year. Fresher's are informed about the various Library rules and services.
- 2) **CAS**: Useful information related to research work, seminars, and workshops is shared with faculties using email or WhatsApp.
- 3) **Reference**: Assistance is provided to students for locating books.
- 4) **Referral**: Students are provided information about various public libraries and Colleges where useful information is available.

- 5) **Overnight Book Lending:** Periodicals and restricted books are given for overnight reading to students.
- 6) **Reprography:** A photocopying facility is available in the library at reasonable rates.
- 7) **Book Bank facility:** The facility was started in December 2018. Selected students are issued books from the book bank for the entire semester.
- 8) **Newspaper Clipping Service:** All the important news clippings are filed date-wise and made available for students from time to time.



Rules and Regulations

Working Hours

- ❖ The Library functions from Monday to Saturday from 8:30 a.m to 5:00 p.m
- ❖ The library will be closed on Sundays and all public holidays.

Discipline

- ❖ All users must observe total silence in the library and its environs at all times.
- ❖ Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the library.
- ❖ All bags, cases, folders etc. must be left in the luggage area in the library.
- ❖ Users are not allowed to leave their baggage overnight in the library. The library shall not take any responsibility for loss of personal property or books already signed out to a user.
- ❖ Anyone caught marking, defacing or mutilating books or any other library resources shall have to pay for the damage.
- ❖ Good order must be observed in the library at all times for example placing of feet on furniture, eating and drinking, smoking, sleeping etc. shall not be allowed.
- ❖ Group discussions are not allowed and noise must be kept to a minimum and should not disturb any other user in the library.
- ❖ Shifting of chairs from one place to another place is strictly prohibited.
- ❖ If a student feels any deficiency in the services of the Library, the same may be brought to the notice of the Librarian immediately for necessary improvement in the services of the Library.
- ❖ Any violation of the library rules by a student shall stop him/her from availing Library services.
- ❖ The library is only for the staff members and bonafide students of the college, outsiders and ex-students will NOT be allowed in the library without prior permission of the Librarian OR the Higher Authorities.

Learning Resource Borrowing Procedure

- ❖ A user must be a registered student for the current Academic year.
- ❖ All students must present their college ID card before borrowing any learning resources from the Library.
- ❖ Students are allowed to borrow a maximum of two books for a period of one week.
- ❖ Students are not allowed to borrow books on behalf of others or transfer borrowed learning resources to other students.
- ❖ Students who repeatedly fail to return the books on due date will lose the privilege of membership of the library.

Overdue Charges/ Fines

A late fee will be charged if the books are not returned within the due date as per the norms shown below:

- For a week after the due date : Rs. 1/- per day per book
- From 2nd week onwards : Rs. 2/- per day per book
- After one month : Rs. 5/- per day per book

Learning resources can only be used within the library

- ❖ Reference books like Handbooks, Dictionaries and Encyclopedias.
- ❖ Newspapers
- ❖ Journals and magazines.

Damage/ Loss of Library Resources

- ❖ Once a book is issued to the student, he/she shall be held solely responsible for any damage spoilage, or mutilation of the book detected subsequently.

Students will be charged for repair or replacement of books and other Library resources to which they have caused damage.

- ❖ Lost books must be reported to the librarian immediately and replaced or paid for within 30 days.
- ❖ Lost library books that are recovered, must be handed over to the librarian as they remain the property of the college library.

Internet Access

- ❖ Internet facility within the Library premises will be provided from 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. from Monday to Saturday.
- ❖ Students are informed that use of internet will be monitored.
- ❖ If a student is found visiting inappropriate sites, strict action will be taken.
- ❖ Access is available only for academic purpose, as such social networking sites are banned.
- ❖ The speed and availability of the internet will depend upon the technical feasibility.
- ❖ Any other matter not covered under the above rules will be decided by the system administrator in consultation with the head of the institution.

Librarians lead the way

NT BUZZ

Prabodhan Education Society's Vidya Prabodhini College of Commerce, Education, Computer and Management, Parvuri organised a state-level workshop on 'Academic Writing Support Services and Web 2.0'. The workshop was attended by a total of 54 librarians and students of library science from different colleges, higher secondary schools, high schools and institutions.

Chief guest at the workshop was national vice president, Vidya Bharti, Dilip Betekar. Also present was chairman, Prabodhan Education Society, Prabhakar Bhat, resource person, Munesh Kumar; librarian, National Institute of Technology (NIT), Farmagudi, Sukhaji Naik; vice principal of the college, Nitesh Naik; principal, MR Patil, and secretary of the workshop, Sunny Pandhre.

Addressing the gathering, Naik explained the broader objective of the workshop in benefitting librarians. While Betekar during his inaugural address recognised

the important role of librarians in meeting the teaching and learning needs of teachers and students. He informed that librarians are the leaders of education and they have to continuously upgrade and update themselves to meet the present day requirements. He further said: "When we learn, we do not earn and when we earn we do not learn. People should have an urge to learn something new. We spend a substantial amount of our income on entertainment and other things but spend a very negligible amount on education. Librarians have to reach out to the unreached."

During his technical session, Munesh Kumar shared useful knowledge about important components like plagiarism control and citation, publication of e-books, internet-based learning applications and writing, and collaboration tools. Kumar also discussed various internet-based learning applications. Several doubts and queries of participants were explained and cleared as part of the session.

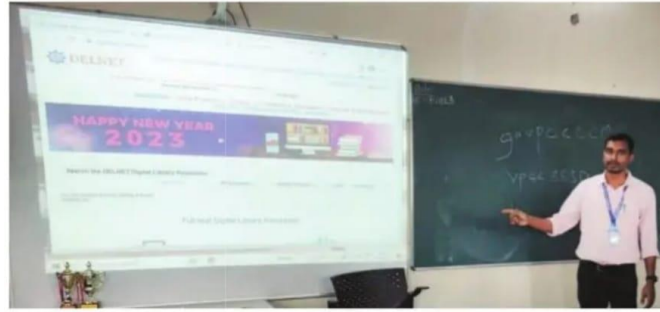
