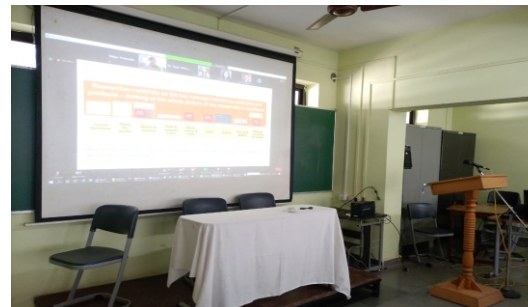
## Activities of 2019-20

### Visit to Forum for Innovation Incubation Research and Entrepreneurship (FiiRE)

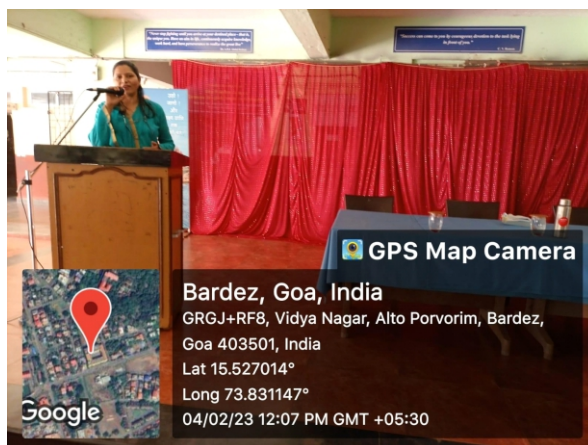



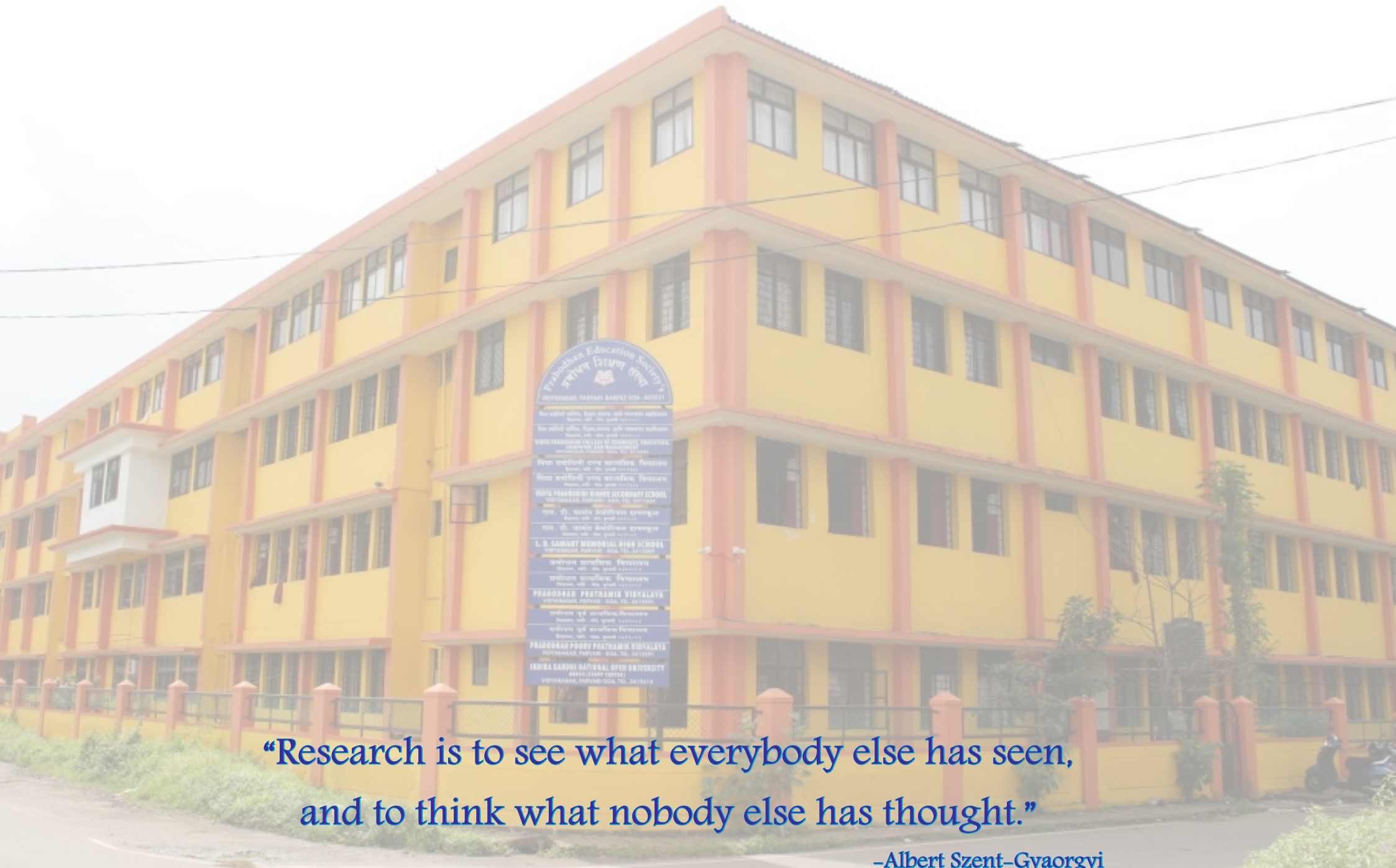
